When We All Vote is working to increase participation in every election — and that starts with making sure eligible voters across the country are registered and ready to vote in their state's presidential primary election.

Every state and territory in the U.S. has its own presidential primary or caucus. This year, the primary season officially began on February 3 and ends in the summer. Voter registration deadlines and election days are different for every state, so we want to make sure you have the information and resources you need to register and vote.

Note: Some states hold their presidential and state primary elections on the same day, while others hold them on different days. Check your state guide or your Secretary of State's website for more information.
